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Palazzo Ca' Zanardi

Palazzo Ca' Zanardi (Cannaregio 4132, Venice) is a residential palace dating back to the 16th century which, over the centuries, has been added on to by various noble Venetian families and is one of the most evocative and beautiful palaces in the city of Venice. Sumptuous and possessing particular charm, Ca' Zanardi is located in a most peaceful setting and has its own delightful private garden as well as a magnificent terrace full of sun and colours. Ca' Zanardi is located close to the Ca' D'Oro, the splendid 15th century gothic palace along the Grand Canal. It is easily reachable by foot, after a two minute walk from the Ca' D'Oro water bus stop, or by boat using the palazzo's private pier positioned along the fetching Santa Caterina canal. The refined elegance of the palazzo's halls and common areas and the delicacy of its original 16th century furnishings create a fascinating setting.
